### **PROJECTS ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING:**

*The Community Stewardship Grant Program provides resources for projects in Alameda County or within an Alameda County watershed that contain a stormwater pollution prevention message and produces a community/public outreach element. Sample projects could include (but are not limited to):*

- ◆ *Outreach and education projects with a stormwater pollution prevention message such as watershed protection, household hazardous waste disposal, anti-litter, Integrated Pest Management techniques, etc.*
- ◆ *Development and distribution of outreach materials (e.g., video, newsletter, website, brochures, guidebook, and others).*
- ◆ *Art projects*
- ◆ *Creek side restoration/revegetation projects*
- ◆ *Wildlife habitat projects*
