

Coastal Program Coordinator (GS-12), Carlsbad Fish and Wildlife Office (CFWO)

The Carlsbad Fish and Wildlife Office (CFWO) is seeking a highly skilled and motivated individual to join the CFWO team as the Coastal Program Coordinator (GS-12). The CFWO is a dynamic office located in a biodiversity hotspot. The office serves a six county area in southern California that includes more than 17 million people, more than 100 threatened or endangered species, 28 Congressional Districts, and 29 Indian Tribes. The urbanization, military presence, and development pressures in southern California make this one of the most exciting, challenging, complex, and controversial places to work on conserving and restoring natural resources. The CFWO currently has a resource management budget of about \$9 million and a staff of approximately 90.

Our office is located in a newer building just 1 mile from the beach. Carlsbad is located north of San Diego, California (about 35 miles from the San Diego airport). The ocean beaches, Mexico, the desert, and the mountains are all easily accessible.
