Wetland Technician Position – Seasonal - 2008

Point Reyes National Seashore is seeking a wetland biologist to assist with field and office work for a wetland restoration project in Point Reyes Station in Marin County. This person would be an employee of the Point Reyes National Seashore Association, a non-profit organization that provides support for Point Reyes National Seashore.

This would be a full-time position starting in the spring of 2008 and running through December 2008, with a potential for extension into 2009 depending on funding. For current students planning to complete school in spring 2008, position could be part-time during spring 2008 until course work is completed and then move to full-time for the summer and fall 2008.

Experience with vegetation monitoring, botanical surveys, wetland delineations, monitoring of other wetland components, and Access database and/or GIS (either ArcView or ArcGIS) is required. Work will involve assistance with implementation of restoration, including construction monitoring and revegetation, as well as monitoring of vegetation, soils, invertebrates, fisheries, and other indicators within the proposed restoration site and reference areas. In addition, the biologist will assist with development and maintenance of a database for information and assist with or independently prepare reports and permits. Strong writing and organizational skills are a must. Applicant should have a degree in Biology, with at least some coursework in Ecology.

The position is open starting immediately. It should be noted that position could often entail long hours in the field, performing strenuous, muddy tasks and possible contact with ticks, poison oak, and other field hazards. Pay will be hourly and commensurate with educational level and experience (\$16.68 to \$20.66 per hour). Relocation expenses will not be paid as part of this position, nor will housing be provided. San Francisco area is an extremely high cost of living area. Please research housing conditions before submitting resume. A background and/or security investigation required. Valid driver's license required.
