

At the last East Subregion meeting, there was a question about access to the website. Instructions follow.

Go to the Bay Area IRWMP website at <http://bairwmp.org/> (You can see upcoming meetings, including East Subregion meetings, on the right side of this page.)

Click “Contact Us” link at the bottom of the left sidebar.

The bottom three sections on that webpage may be of interest to you.

- **Get on the Email List** – puts you on the email list for the Bay Area IRWMP to receive meeting announcements and other pertinent information that relates to the Bay Region. This is not a substitution to the email list I manage for the East Subregion.

- **Website Access** – gives you the ability to log into the website and access more information than otherwise.

§ This website has a sophisticated search engine. Typing in the search box at the upper right will quickly help you find projects or other pages you are looking for. For example, type in “east sub” and it will quickly show the folder for the East Subregion (mentioned below).

§ This webpage will be updated over the next year. One feature that should be added is a better navigation and better on-line project database so you can input/update your own project information that will be used in the updating the Bay Area Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (IRWMP).

- **Subregional Coordination** – is a link to the subregion folders including the folder for our **East Subregion**. I plan to use this folder for meetings (agendas and notes) and other key documents. I was able to get to everything but the meeting details (agendas and notes) without logging on. I’m hoping to find a way to make the details available without logging in.

I hope this information is helpful. If you have problems accessing the information, or have questions/comments, please let me know.
