ADDENDUM NO. 1 TO THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA INTEGRATED REGIONAL WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE

You are hereby notified of the following changes, deletions, additions, and clarifications to the Request for Proposals (RFP), Scope of Work, and other documents comprising the RFP package for the **San Francisco Bay Area Integrated Regional Water Management Plan Update**.

1. Delete Element 16 – Climate Change, in Attachment A, Scope of Work.
2. Insert the following revised language for Element 16 – Climate Change, in Attachment A, Scope of Work:

16. Climate Change

This element involves developing a new *Climate Change* section for the Plan, with a focus on Climate Change Adaptation, and instilling Climate Change Adaptation as an overarching theme throughout the Plan. A [Draft Handbook – Regional Water Management Planning with Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation](#) (available at: [MAY 17th DRAFT CC HANDBOOK](#)) provides guidance on addressing the Climate Change Standard.

This element includes conducting an Initial Vulnerability Assessment, Impacts Measurement, Strategy Evaluation, and addressing Implementation Under Uncertainty, as outlined in the Draft Handbook (sections 4, 5, 6 and 7).

In addition, work for this element will include identifying mapping tools to help evaluate vulnerabilities, identifying water/wastewater/flood infrastructure in the region that may be affected by climate change, establishing a library of reports and resources on Climate Change specific to the Bay Area region, proposing Climate Change Adaptation policies and programs for inclusion in Plan, and presentation of draft *Climate Change* section to BCDC, Joint Policy Committee, AQMD and other agencies working on climate change for comments and to coordinate future efforts. Work in this element will also include the collection and description of any information developed by project proponents concerning greenhouse gas emissions associated with projects that are proposed and evaluated under Element 6, Project Review Process.

Key Outcome(s)

- Identification of vulnerabilities.
- Clarity regarding degree of impacts.
- Identification of adaptation strategies.
- Collection of recent and relevant climate change studies, reports, analyses, maps, and other relevant resources specific to the Bay Area region.

- Comprehensive description of climate change impacts and water management adaptation strategies for the Bay Area IRWM Region, including policies and procedures for adaptive management.

Deliverable(s)

- Initial Vulnerability Assessment
- Impacts Measurement
- Strategy Evaluation
- Information provided by project proponents on greenhouse gas emissions associated with projects included in the Plan.
- Electronic library, accessible on the Bay Area IRWM web site, of up-to-date climate change documents and resources specific to the Bay Area region.
- Draft *Climate Change* section for review and comment by the Coordinating Committee and other interested parties
- Final *Climate Change* section for the Plan update

Schedule: Suggested time frame for completing the update of the *Climate Change* section is November 2011 through January 2013.
