

Please help us hand-remove Algerian sea lavender from Corte Madera Ecological Reserve Sunday December 4th 11AM-4:30PM. We've had great success so far and are close to completing initial removal on all the Marin County sites, and partners around the Bay are also removing it from their lands with the goal of eradication from San Francisco Bay wetlands (see attachment for more information).
